# 10TH MEETING OF ENTREPRENEURS FOR ECONOMIC COOPERATION BETWEEN CHINA AND PORTUGUESE-SPEAKING COUNTRIES



NSRF participated in the "10th Meeting of Chinese Entrepreneurs of Portuguese Speaking Countries", which took place in Lisbon, last June, and brought together members of the government of China, the Macao SAR and Portugal, as well as the representatives of the entities that promote the investment in China and Portuguese-speaking Countries, entrepreneurs and associations in these countries.

### SIGNATURE OF A PROTOCOL TO PROMOTE PORTUGUESE LANGUAGE

Signature of a Protocol between the DLC, an associate company of NSRF, FLUL - Faculty of Letters of the University of Lisbon - and FLUL's Association for Development. #### **SILK ROAD TRIP**

NSRF organized a trip to the Old Chinese Silk Road, which took place between 2-17 September.

The trip, which began in Xian and ended in Kashgar, contemplated visits to several points of this road, from beautiful natural landscapes to historical places, some of which integrated into the cultural heritage of humanity, by UNESCO.
